## WEATHERFAST A2 FINISHING TIMBER OIL

**DESCRIPTION:** A finishing timber oil designed to highlight the natural grain of the timber whilst slowing down the degradation of the substrate.

**USES:** Primary use is to protect the timber by using the maximum and best UV inhibitors available.

### PROPERTIES (at 25°C)

**COLOUR:** Light amber

**TOXICITY:** N/A

**FINISH:** Gloss

**COVERAGE:** 10-12sq. metres per litre.

**DRYING TIME:** 3 hours at 25C and 50% relative humidity.

**RECOATING:** A minimum of 4 coats (maximum 6) is required for exterior use. Sanding is not required if each coat is applied within 2 days.

**POT LIFE:** N/A

**MIXING RATIO:** N/A

**THINNING:** Not recommended

**WEIGHT/LITRE:** 920g/litre

**VOLUME SOLIDS:** 51%

**FLASH POINT:** 37°C

**CLEAN UP:** Weatherfast Brushing Thinners

**U.N. NUMBER:** 1263

- PREPARATION:**       **Previously Oiled Timber:** A light sand with 120 grit sand paper, then clean with Norclean-Plus using a **paper towel**. However, if the timber is porous use the A1 first. If the timber is grey, use the Norglass Grey-Away.
- Bare Timber:** Apply 2-3 coats of the A1 penetrating timber oil prior to using the A2 finish.
- APPLICATION:**       Stir contents thoroughly. Apply by brush or roller (short 4mm mohair).  
Do not thin.  
A minimum of 4 coats (maximum 5) for exterior use.  
2 coats can be applied the same day.  
Light foot traffic after 24 hours.
- TRANSPORTATION:** Flammable liquid. Dangerous Goods Class 3.2.  
Sizes available - 10litre, 4litre, 2litre, 1litre.
- PRECAUTIONS:**       Provide adequate ventilation during use.  
Keep away from naked flame and do not smoke.  
Do not use in damp conditions or below 10 C.
- FIRST AID:**           If poisoning occurs call a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Aust) on 13 11 26 or (NZ) 0800 764 766 and have label information ready.  
If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. Give large quantities of water or milk. In case of eye contact, flush immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and consult a doctor. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do and continue rinsing. If skin contact causes irritation, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly. If breathing difficulty arises remove to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if not breathing.
